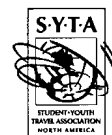

The USS Constitution (also known as Old Ironsides), the oldest commissioned warship afloat in the world, is open every day from 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Guided tours are available every ½ hour beginning at 10:30 a.m. with the last tour beginning at 4:30 p.m. on a first come first serve availability. A specific tour time cannot be requested. Each ½ hour tour is led by one of the ship's active-duty Navy crew members and is designed to bring visitors face to face with the ships storied history, her construction and the men and women who sailed her from historic battles to today.

After visit to the USS Constitution, visit **Faneuil Hall & Quincy Marketplace**

Enjoy dinner "on your own" at the variety of fast food restaurants and shopping at the variety of stores located at Faneuil Hall & Quincy Marketplace.
